The Social Inclusion Forum (SIF) is part of the structures put in place by the Government to support the development and implementation of its plans to address poverty and social exclusion. The event provides a forum for consultation and discussion on social inclusion issues, particularly with people experiencing poverty and social exclusion and the groups that work with them.

In 2018, the theme of the SIF is *Social Inclusion in a Changing Environment*. It will explore issues such as using the Public Sector Duty as a tool for change; Strengthening the voice of the Social Inclusion Forum; Equality Proofing Public Expenditure; Childcare Policies; and Community Work at local level. There will also be a discussion on using the Sustainable Development Goals

The consultation process will include a series of regional meetings and focus groups hosted by Community Work Ireland and EAPN Ireland that will inform a wider consultation process at the annual Social Inclusion Forum.
