Proposed changes to animal control at Beach

Horses permitted on All beaches as normal from April – August, from 5am – 11am daily.

Horses restricted from traversing the dunes at Mornington and Bettystown – to protect flora and fauna.
 (Recommendation 21 – Beach Management Plan)

Horses restricted from beach at River Nanny Estuary and Shore SPA from September to March except for Laytown Races – this is to protect winter feeding birds.
 (Recommendation 22 – Beach Management Plan)

Laytown Races will not be affected by these changes and will continue as normal.

Dogs to be kept on a lead on the beaches all year around – for comfort and safety of visitors, to prevent dog fouling and for protection of birds, in winter months, at River Nanny Estuary and Shore SPA.
 (Recommendation 20 – Beach Management Plan)
