



New eLearning introductory module in Equality and Human Rights in the Public Service

To support public bodies to understand and meet their obligations under the **Public Sector Equality and Human Rights Duty** set out in Section 42 of the Irish Human Rights and Equality Commission Act 2014. ¹ The Irish Human Rights and Equality Commission (IHREC) have developed a new eLearning module called **Equality and Human Rights in the Public Service**. The purpose of the eLearning is to build understanding of equality and human rights concepts, legislation and approaches to implementing the **Public Sector Duty**.

What will you learn?

There are three units in the eLearning module.

- **Unit 1: Equality in the Public Service** – Introduces you to equality and the equality obligations of public bodies and explores issues facing staff and service users.
- **Unit 2: Human Rights in the Public Service** – Introduces you to human rights concepts and human rights obligations of public bodies and explores issues facing staff and service users.
- **Unit 3: The Public Sector Equality and Human Rights Duty** introduces you to the Public Sector Duty and the steps involved in its implementation.
