## **Project: Ballivor Wind Farm – Significant Additional Information**

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with an update on the proposed Ballivor Wind Farm. As you may be aware, on the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023, Bord na Móna Powergen Ltd submitted a planning application to An Bord Pleanála (ABP) for the proposed project. In response to submissions received in respect of this planning application, Bord na Móna Powergen Ltd. provided Additional Information to ABP. ABP has deemed this to be significant additional information.

This significant additional information, together with the original planning application documentation, Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) and Natura Impact Statement (NIS), may be inspected free of charge or purchased on payment of a specified fee (which shall not exceed the reasonable cost of making such a copy) during public opening hours for a period of 3 weeks commencing **on the 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2024** at the following locations:
