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Ageing Population 2011 - 2022



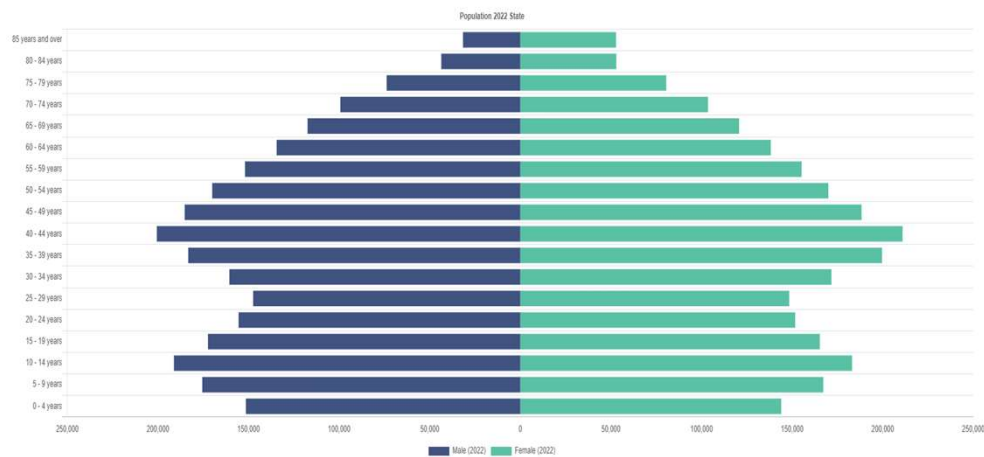

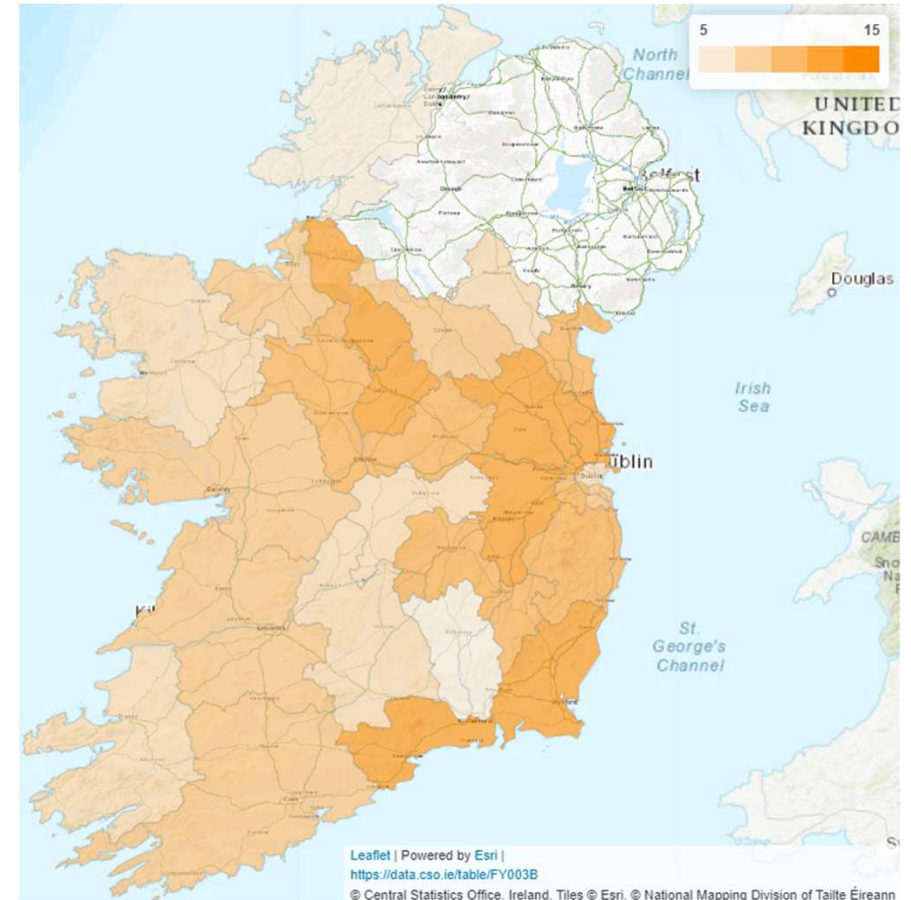
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County Population Changes

- Population growth generally stronger in the east of the country with Meath growing by 13%, followed by Fingal (12%) and Kildare (11%)

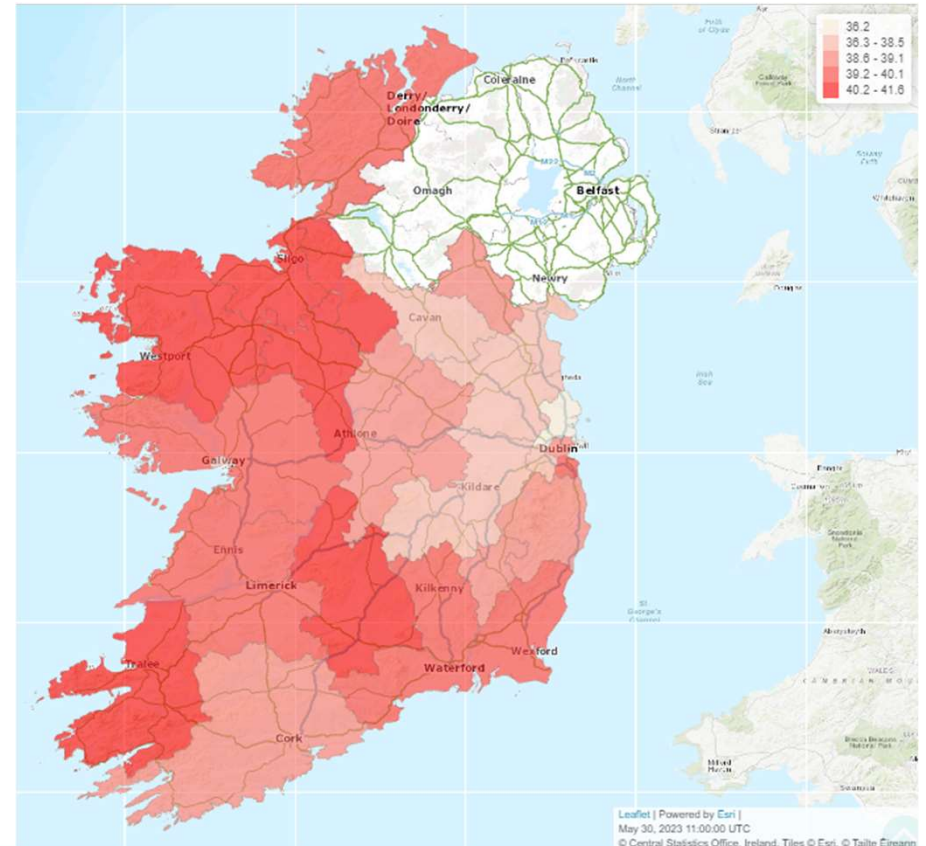
Population change (%), 2016-2022

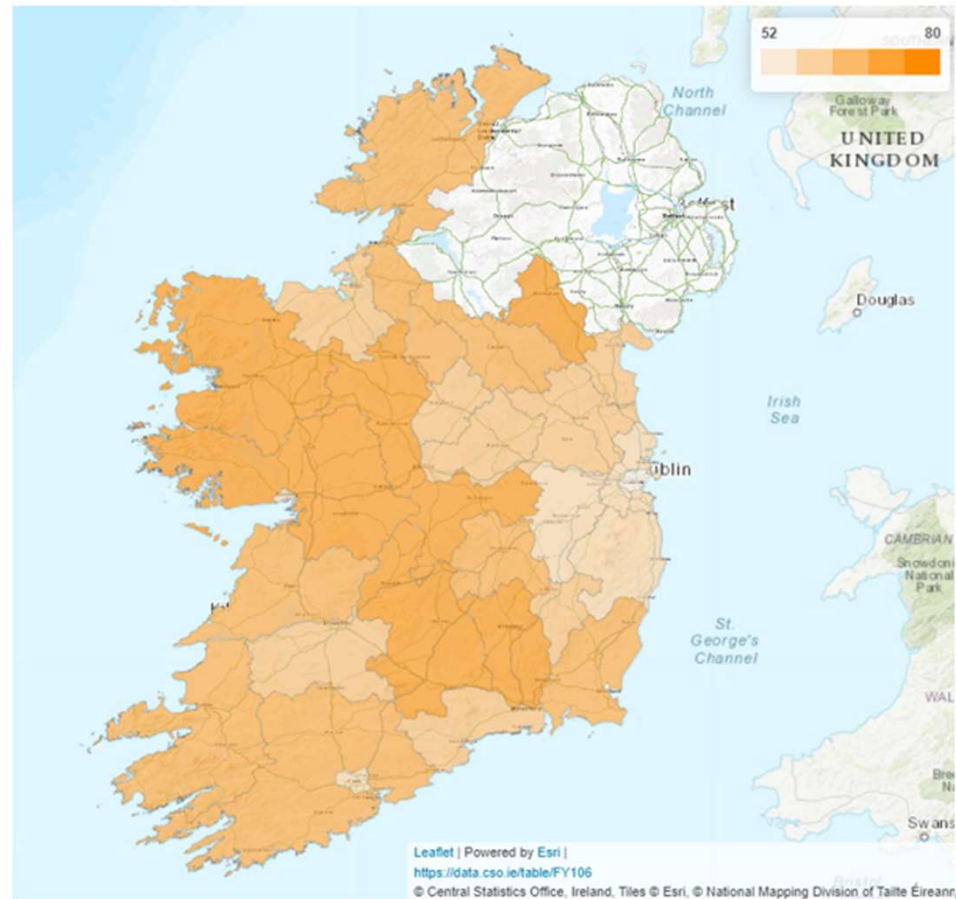

Figure 4.1 Population usually resident and present in the State by citizenship (%), 2022

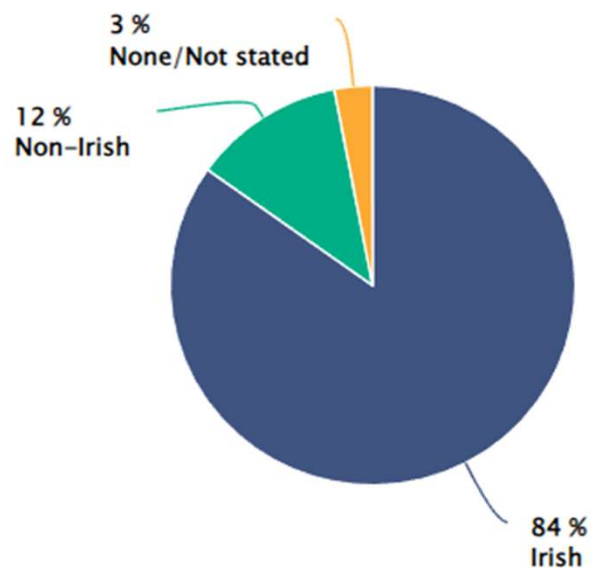
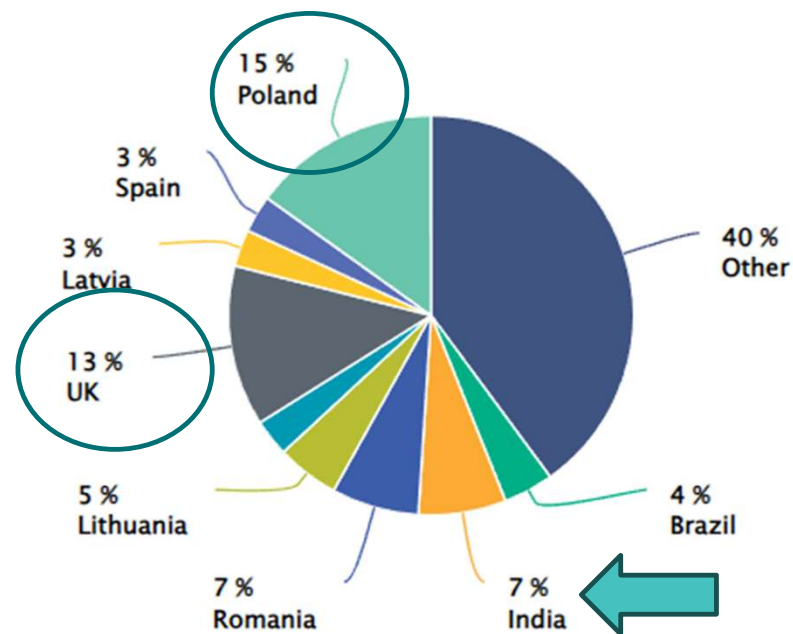


Figure 4.2 Non-Irish population usually resident and present in the State by citizenship (%), 2022

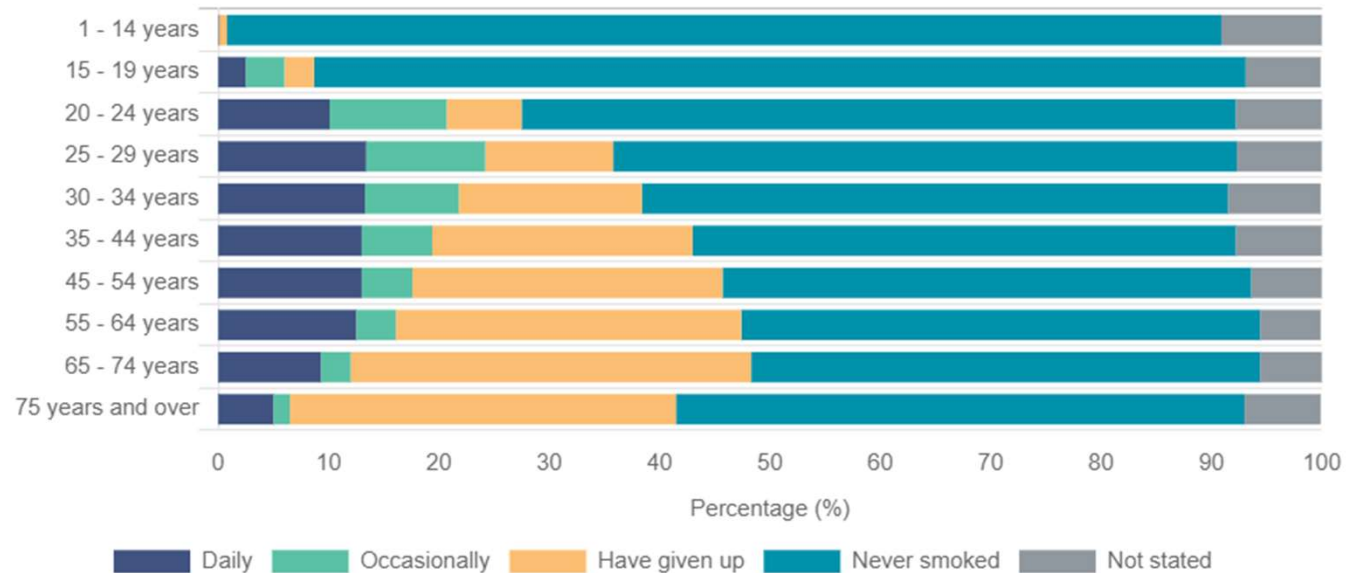

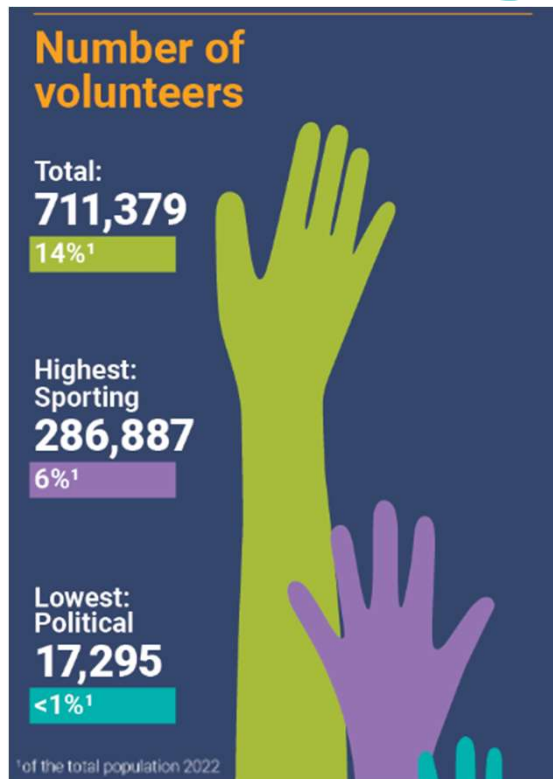
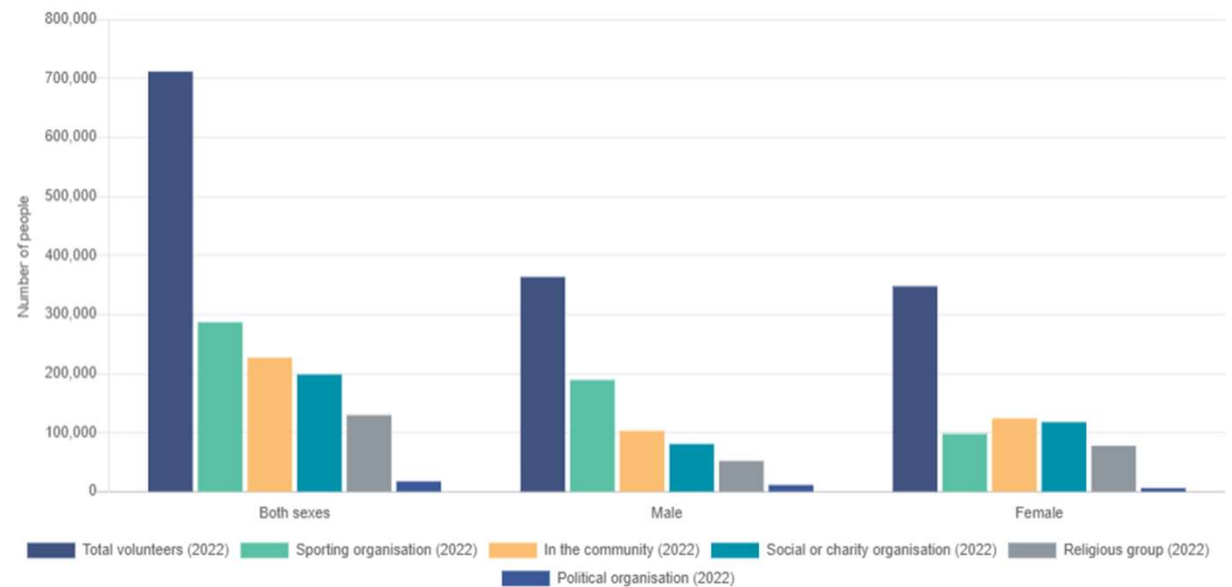


Figure 1.1 Population engaged in voluntary activities by category and sex, 2022

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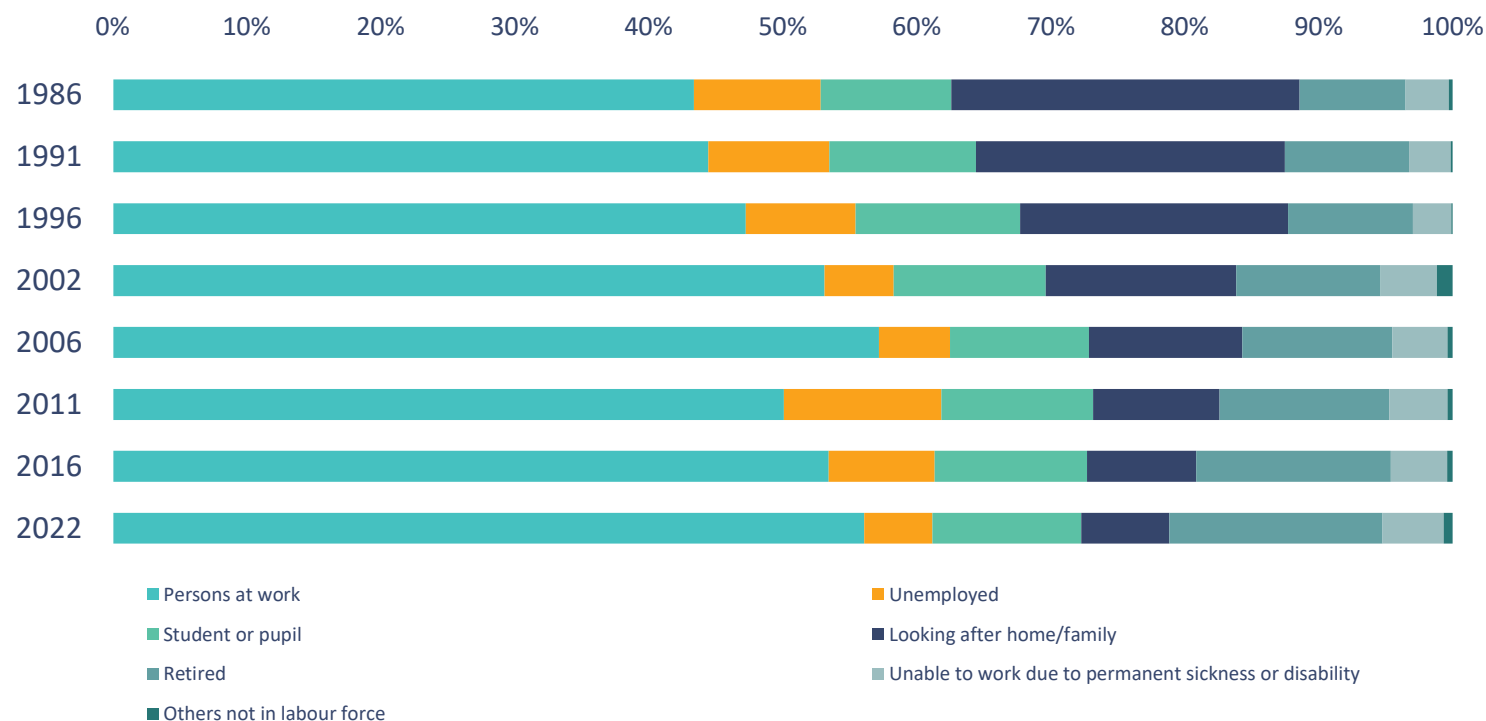

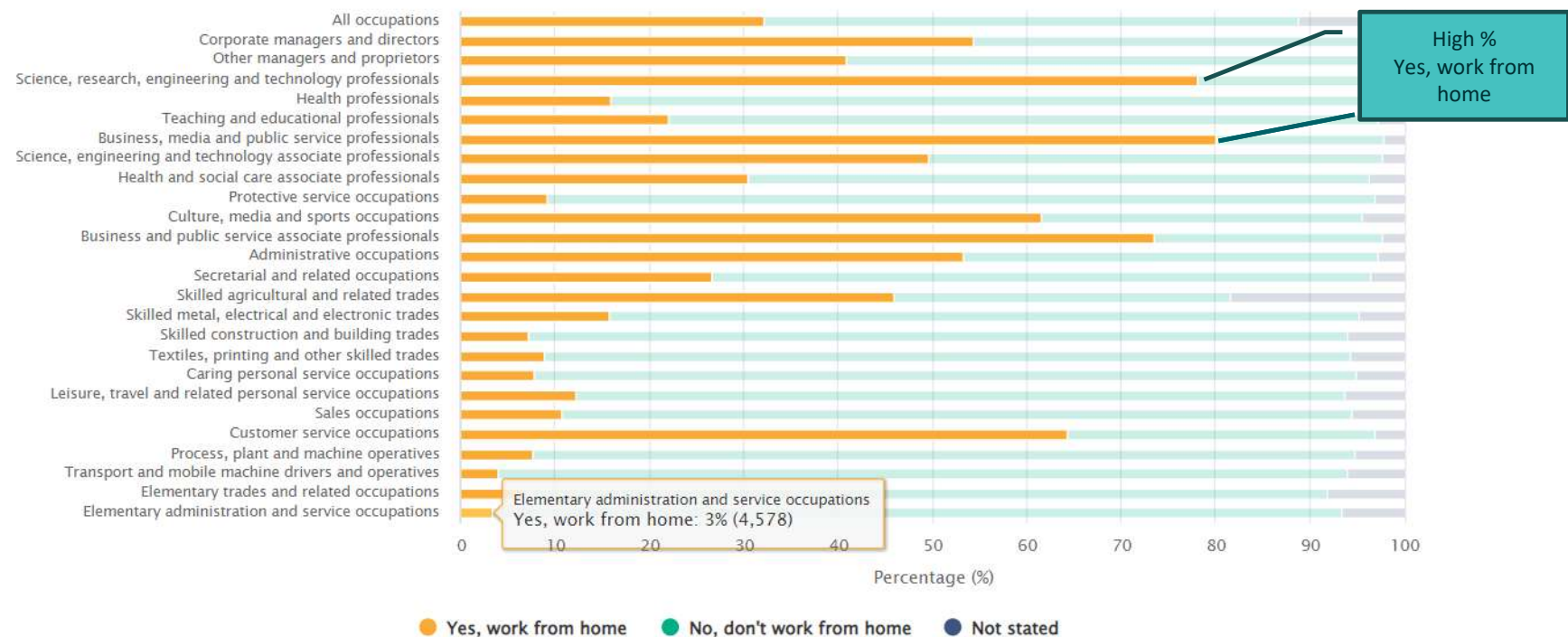
Population aged 15 years and over by principal economic status, 1986 - 2022

Figure 5.13 Population aged 15 years and over by intermediate occupational group and working from home status, 2022





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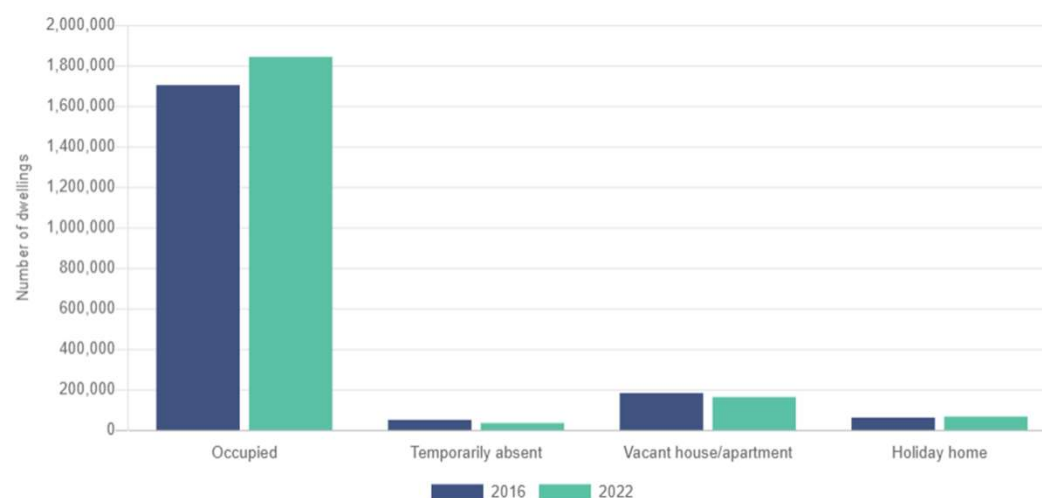
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Housing

Housing Stock, 2016 to 2022

- Census 2022 housing stock was 2,112,121, over 5% higher than in Census 2016
- Occupied households increased by 8% to 1.85 million
- Vacant dwellings fell by nearly 20,000 (-11%) to 163,433
- Holiday homes unoccupied on Census Night rose by 8% from 62,148 to 66,956

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Home ownership and rent



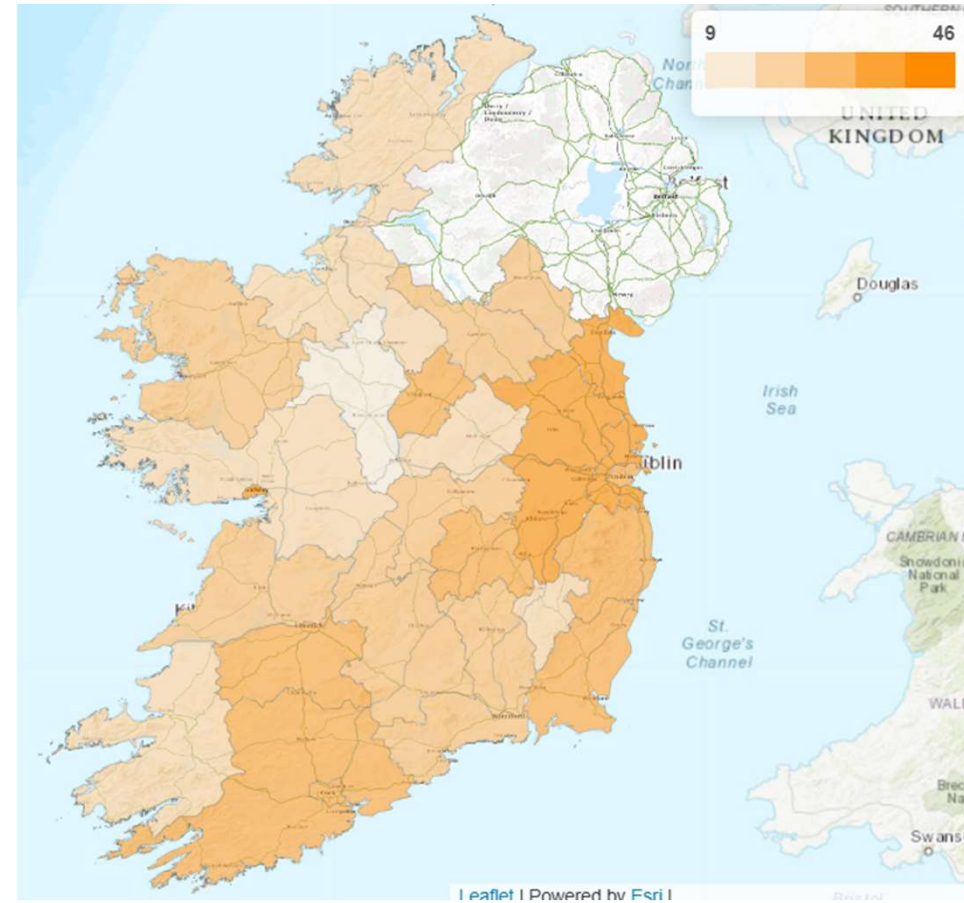
- Home ownership down to 66% in 2022

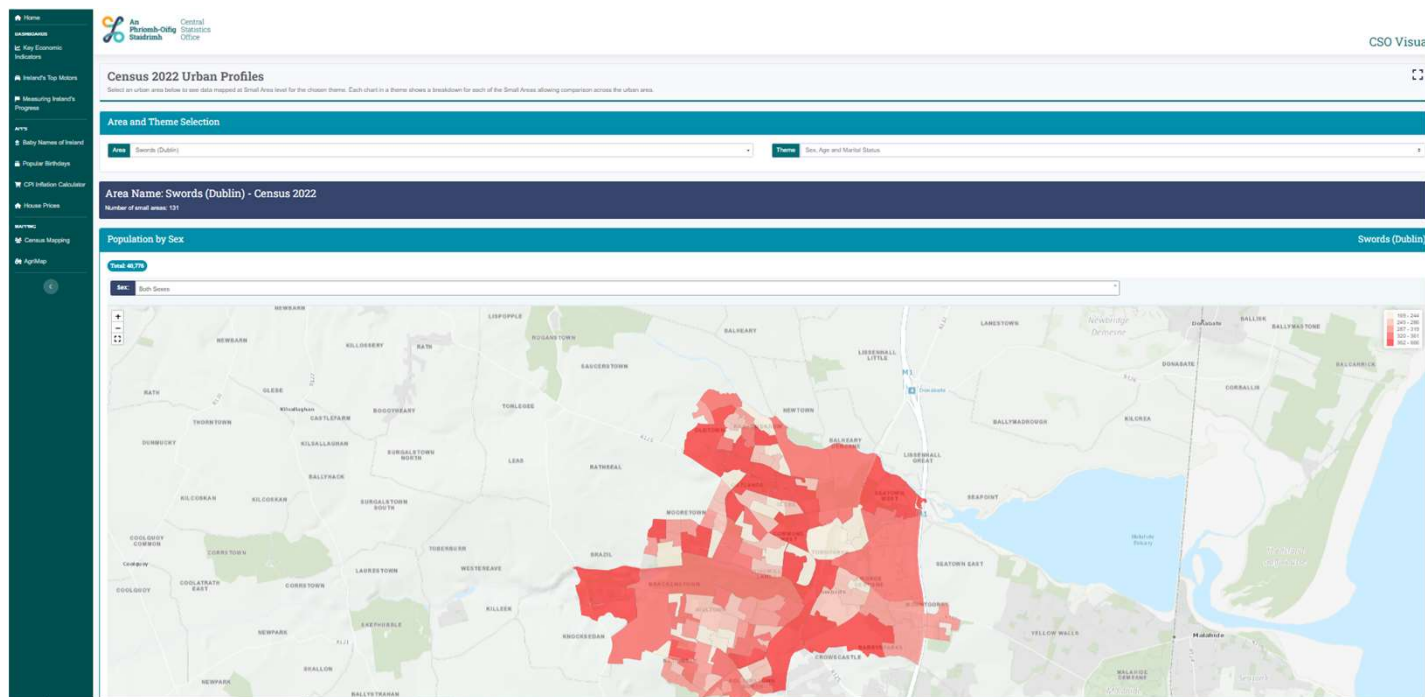

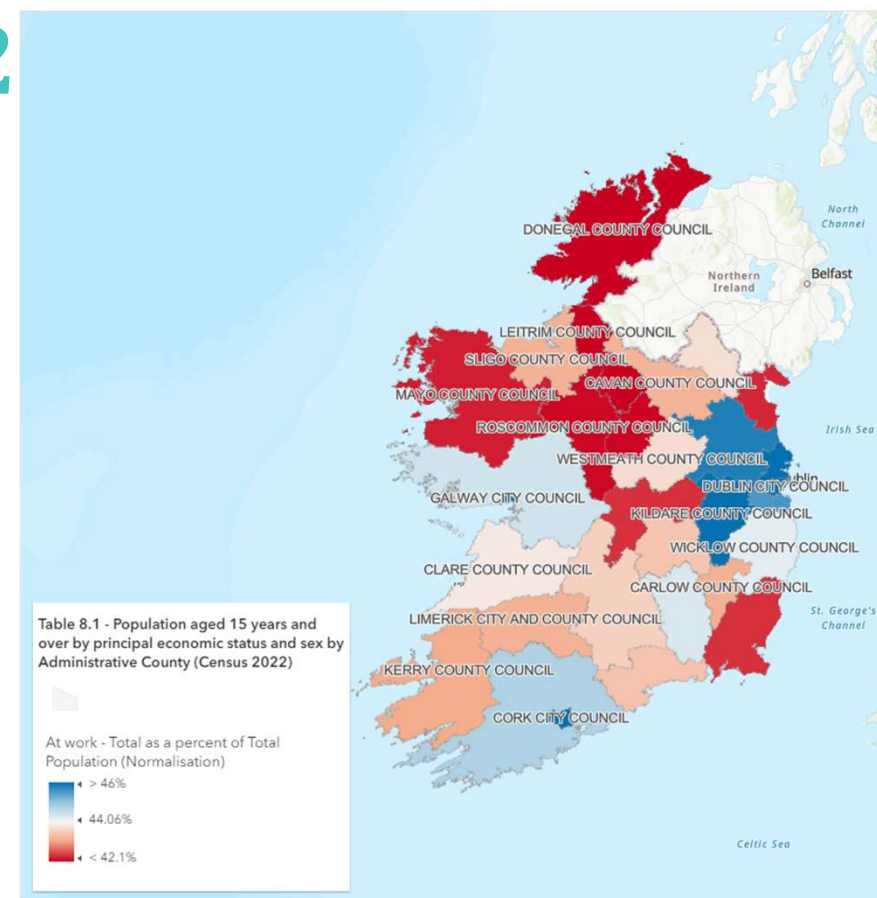
